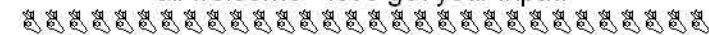
FLEA MARKET/GARAGE SALE

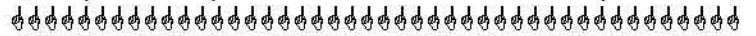

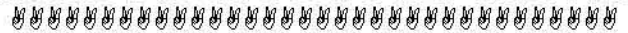

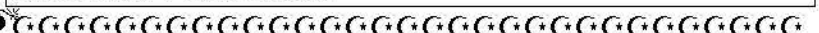


CAMPERS HELPING DISABLED CAMPERS

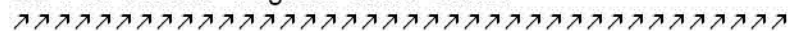
